

2022 Guidelines for Submitting a Documentary

Documentary category students should review the NHD Rule Book to ensure they do not miss any important rules and requirements for their category. Documentary students need to plan to upload a shareable link of their final project by the contest registration deadline. Students should prepare to give themselves plenty of time to complete this process before the deadline. Documentary students also need to save their project paperwork as one PDF file and upload it to the registration system by the deadline.

- Step 1: Create one PDF file that contains the title page, process paper, and annotated bibliography in that order. The registration system only allows one PDF upload, so it must include all required paperwork.
- Step 2: Upload the .MP4 file of the documentary to Google Drive, One Drive, or DropBox. A particular platform is not preferred as long as the documentary can be shared with a link.
- Step 3: Make Google Drive, One Drive, or DropBox Link **Shareable**.
- During the registration process, please remember to submit BOTH documentary paperwork (title page, process paper, annotated bibliography) and a shareable link to your documentary video. **It is your responsibility to make sure the link is shareable.**
